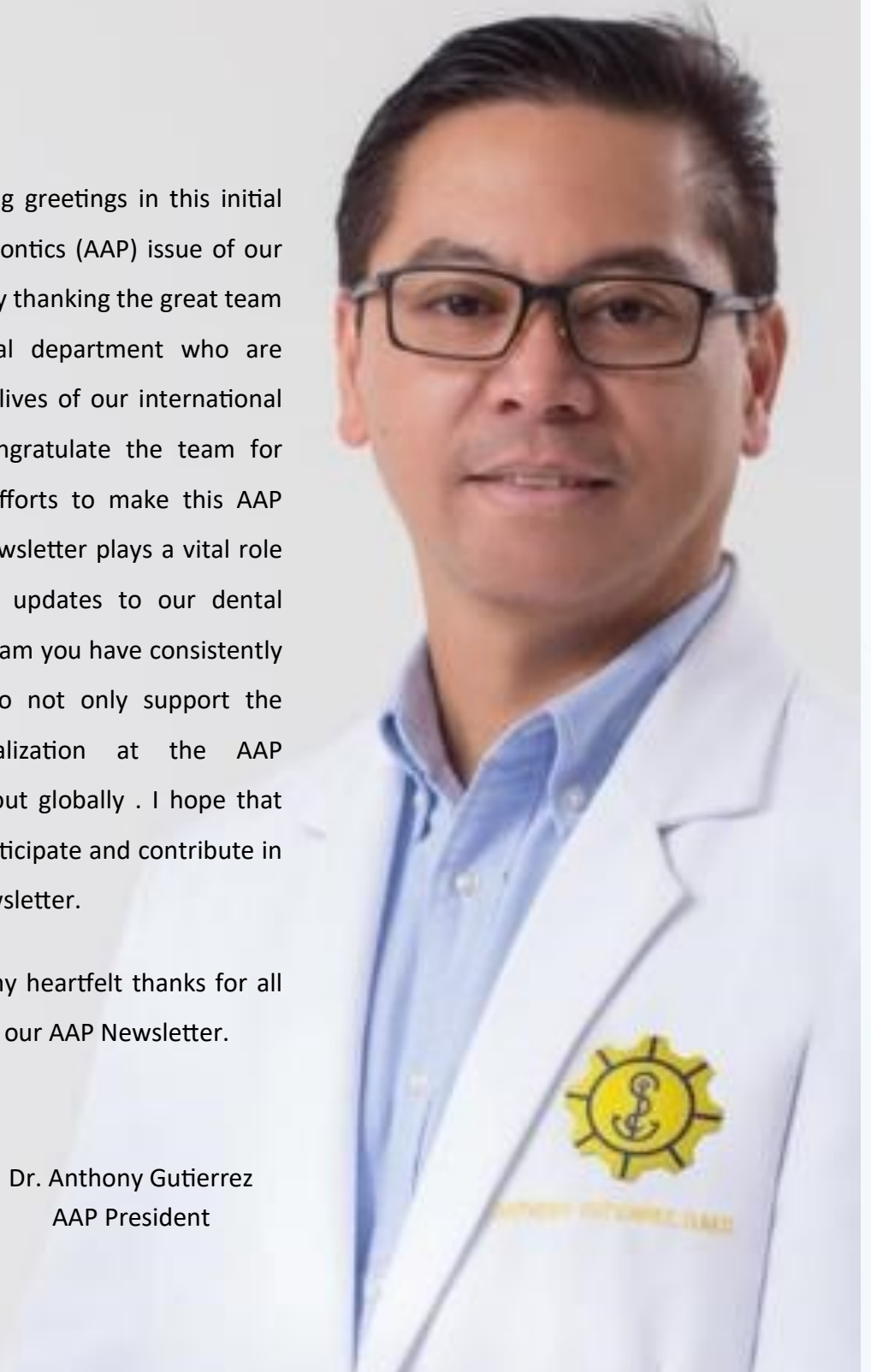

**Q. Can you please highlight the history of AAP? – who initiated it, who are the founder members, where and how did you all meet, what were the goals for setting it up, how did you all communicate?**

The base of AAP was the ICPAC (International College of Prosthodontists Asian chapter, established 1994). Two scientific meetings were held in Kagoshima (1994) and Yokoska (1996) respectively. At that time, ICP (International College of Prosthodontists) tried to have 4 divisions (Asia, Australia, Europe and America) for prosthodontic academic meeting. However, ICP canceled plan and remained as a one organization.

Therefore, key members of ICPAC agreed to change the name of organization from ICPAC to AAP (Asian Academy of Prosthodontics) in 1998 and started as a new Asian Prosthodontic Organization.

### **Brief history of foundation of AAP**

1994. 11.3-4: 1<sup>st</sup> ICPAC meeting in Kagoshima, Japan (president, Kenji-Hiranuma)

1996. 9.21-22: 2<sup>nd</sup> ICPAC meeting in Yokoska, Japan Etsuro Matsuo

1997. 7.15: ICPAC Business meeting was held at Seoul (College of Dentistry, SNU)

At that time, ICP changed the plan to have 4 divisions in the world, ICP stayed as a one organization. The council members of ICPAC decided to change the name of ICPAC to AAP (Asian Academy of Prosthodontics) and elected prof. Yung-Soo Kim as a 1<sup>st</sup> AAP president.

**Q. As the first president of AAP what were your goals and what were the landmark activities you officiated?**

Asian countries have difficulties to attend the international dental meeting because of geographical and economic limitations at that time. Only selective Asian dentists can attend the international meeting for presentation and discuss with western scholars.

For this reasons, organizing Asian prosthodontic community was the main purpose of AAP to provide chance for presenting research and clinical knowledge of Asian dentists.

Not only exchange scientific knowledge but also communicate and share different cultures with new friends during AAP meeting were the goals of organization.

**Q. How was Prosthodontics practiced when you started your career in dentistry? How different was it from what you see now?**

I graduate College of Dentistry, Seoul National University in 1961. Last 60 years, dentistry was evolved tremendously in terms of clinical and basic science. Principles, materials and equipment are introduced to clinical dentistry under the base of fundamentals basic science. Nowadays, Digital science technology (AI,VR, IoT and CAD/CAM etc) was introduced.

However, we should focus on the basic principles and evidence based dentistry when treat patients.

**Q. You have been a successful clinician and academician, can you highlight the requirements of a well-balanced professional and personal life management?**

Everyone should have solid principles and knowledge on the treatment of patient as a dentist. A dentist with research mind and philanthropy would be excellent clinicians. Endless journey to learn and study to improve ourselves and we have to cultivate global mind to care of other side of the world.

Most of all, your family are the most important part in your life.

**Q. What is the history of the Kim Award? (When was it started, what was its objectives, who was the first winner).**

ICPAC 1<sup>st</sup> president Hiranuma made the Hiranuma award (1996) and I think there should be another award to encourage the young Prosthodontist to present their research and clinical cases at the scientific meeting.

The Kim award was designed to promote the AAP scientific activities and to celebrate the 1<sup>st</sup> Biennial Congress of Asian Academy of Prosthodontics in Seoul, Korea according to the congress organizing committee's proposal. Award was conferred to the best speaker of the AAP workshop and the 1<sup>st</sup> awardee was the prof. In-Ho Cho (Dankook University, Korea) in 1999,

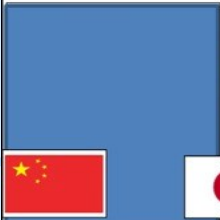

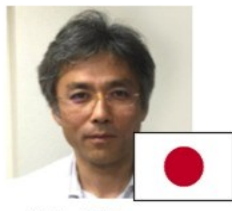

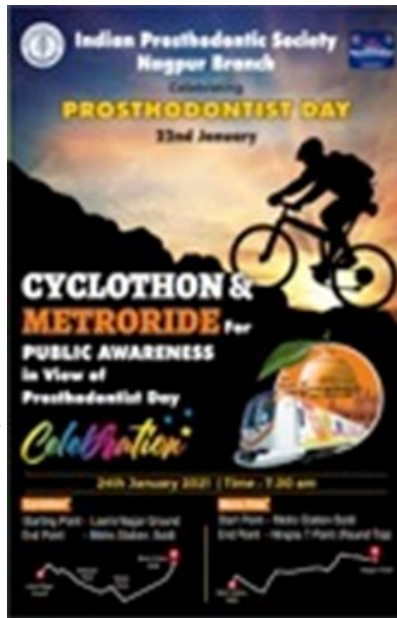
# AAP Members

## Major Events and Program 2021

### Indian Prosthodontic Society

#### Prosthodontist Day 2021 – January 22

It is with the sole objective of Promotion & creating awareness of the specialty among the public that the Prosthodontist Day' was conceived by the IPS and is celebrated on the 22nd of January every year. Besides this the Prosthodontist Day also brings about friendship and camaraderie among its student and life members. The fraternity of Prosthodontists in India and Asia braving the pandemic had come together to celebrate and commemorate this event in a big way once again.



The official launch of the event was done by the IPS president Dr Akshay Bhargava, Dr V Rangarajan was the guest of honour and delivered a prosthodontist Day message. The members of the Indian Prosthodontics Society took part in celebrating the Prosthodontist Day in an unprecedented manner. There were various programs organized in almost all the dental schools across the country which saw various competitions, street plays, cycle rally is, Prostho Run, educational programs exhibitions, denture camps and health awareness programs besides a plethora of other innovative programs.

#### The 48<sup>th</sup> IPS National Conference

The 48<sup>th</sup> Indian Prosthodontic Society National Conference was held on an interactive web platform. The IPS took this decision due to the covid imposed restrictions which prevented a physical meeting. IPS was the only speciality organisation in the country to do so. The conference had a record-breaking 2800 registrations with 40 keynote lectures by speakers of International and national repute, 24 Preconference workshops, 190 faculty presentations, 405 student paper presentations, 300 student poster presentations and 80 table clinic presentations. It was the first ever virtual conference held in the history of the Indian Prosthodontic society as well as any dental speciality in India. The theme of the conference was 'Confluence: Practice with Evidence'

Dr. Usha Radke, Organizing Chairperson of 48th IPS welcomed the gathering. Dr. Doddi Somavinata, President AAP inaugurated the conference and addressed the gathering. Dr. J R Patel, President IPS delivered the presidential address. The annual B C Shroff Oration was delivered by IPS Past President Dr. K R Kashinath who spoke on Occlusion- Confluence of Nature, Mechanics, and Technology. Keynote lectures from a galaxy of both national and international speakers then continued into the 3 days of the phenomenally successful conference.



#### IPS-ISMR Conference (International Society for Maxillofacial Rehabilitation).

The 13th Biennial conference of the ISMR was hosted for the first time in India at Pune in 2021, and IPS hosted this event along with ISMR. This conference was held during the 1st and 2nd week of February 2021. The dates for the conference were revised due to the Covid pandemic and it was conducted on a virtual platform. Conference which was attended by close to 900 delegates worldwide have projected the Indian Prosthodontics Society to international audiences across the world.



#### 24<sup>th</sup> IPS National PG convention

The annual Indian Prosthodontic Society Post Graduate convention was held in an impeccable manner at the Mahatma Gandhi Dental College and hospital Jaipur. This three-day event was conducted on a digital interactive platform due to the Covid pandemic restrictions which prevented a physical meeting. The convention was attended by close to 1500 plus student members.

All the 21 keynote sessions were well attended so were the 28 pre-convention courses. The students presented 280 plus scientific papers, 140 posters and 80 table clinics

### The IPS International Scientific Exchange with the Japan Prosthodontic Society.

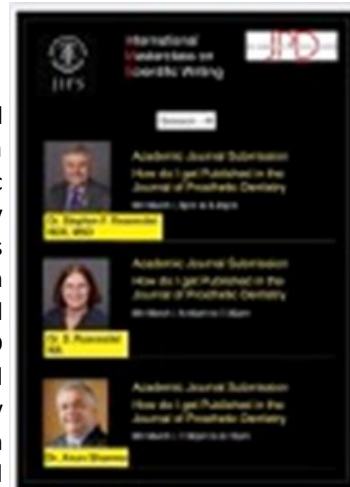

### MOU signed with UNESCO chair of bioethics.

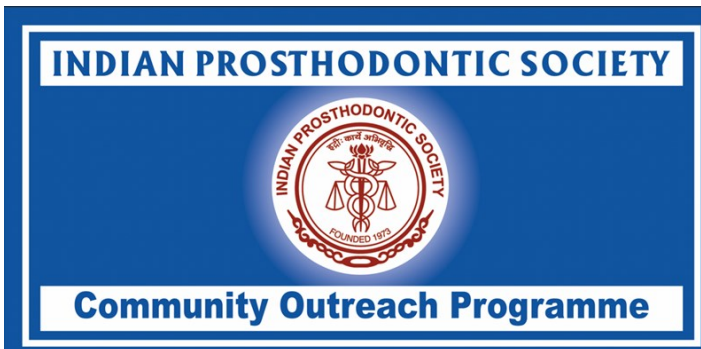

### Community Outreach Program

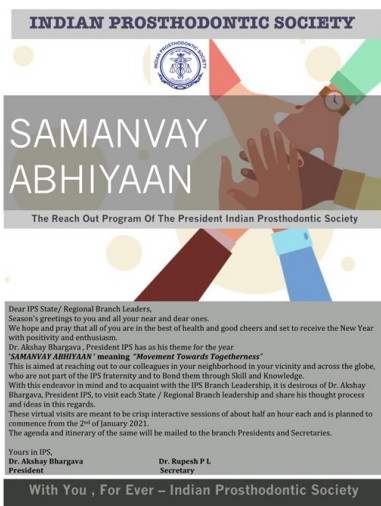

This year the Part 2 examination of the IBP was successfully conducted on 12th and 13th of March 2021.

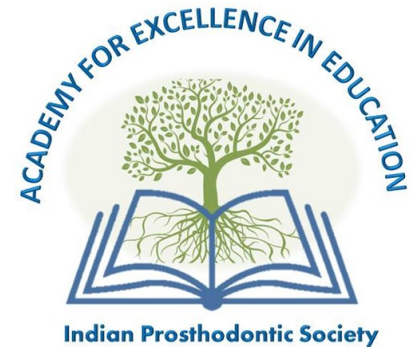
The Part 1 summer examination was conducted on the 25th of July on the Auto proctor portal.

The Indian Prosthodontic Society is pleased to announce that the IPS's one-year Certificate Course in Health Professions Education has commenced on the 8th of October 2021.

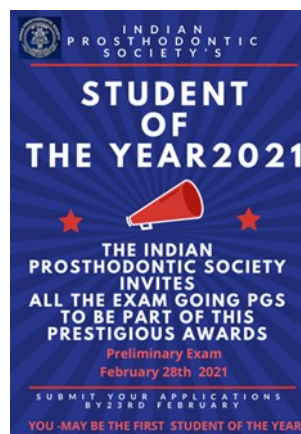
A Keynote lecture was delivered by the world renowned academician Dr William Burdick during the occasion.

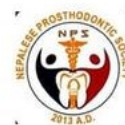


### 2nd PG Convention of NPS

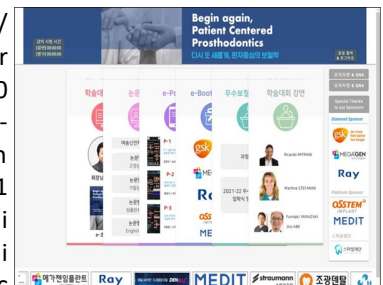
### 6th Prosthetic Teeth Day

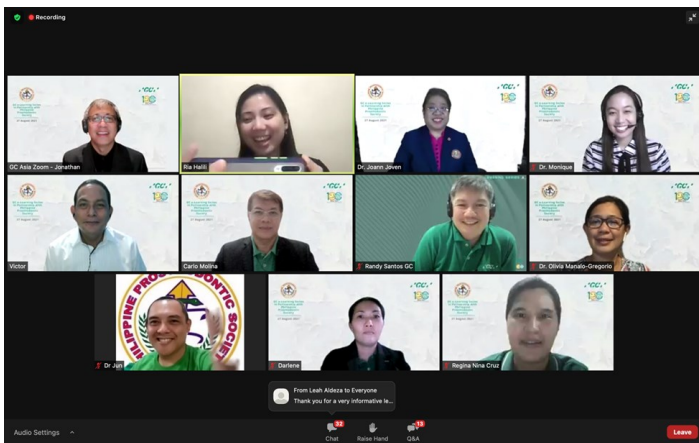
## Website Launching

## PPS GC PHILS. SEMINAR

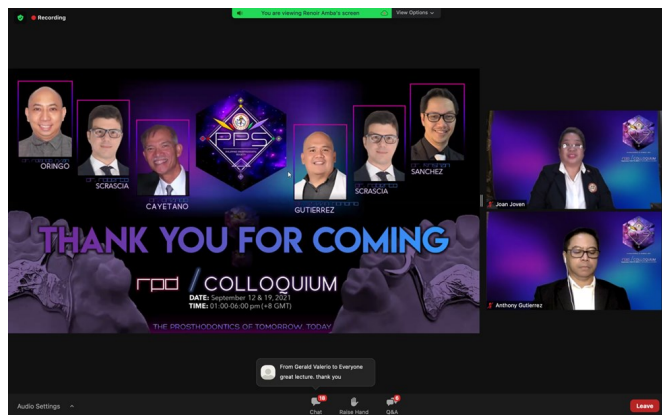
