

Field visits are an essential part of the Community Medicine curriculum, which provide a unique, time intensive and







community-driven learning environment, which can be utilized by the undergraduate students to gain valuable practical experience.

The Department of Community Medicine, CMH LMC and IOD, arranged a field visit of 4th year MBBS to, Rangers' Institute of Special Education (RISE), to raise awareness about children with disabilities and their right to dignity and social inclusivity. The main aim of this visit is to develop empathy and acceptance, mobilize resources and to provide support. During this visit, counseling and support services were provided to the families, encouraging socialization within the community.





The said visit was conducted in two batches. The purpose of which was to raise awareness, conduct researches on specific risk factors, provide rehabilitation and assist in regards to development of skills in disabled individuals in order to increase their quality of life and to



help make their lives productive. For the purpose of better understanding of the general diseases and disabilities, a case control study is also being conducted by the Department of Community Medicine with the assistance of RISE. Fund raising was also done by medical students and an amount of about Rupees 50,000/- was donated to the Institute for Special Children. This department has also planned a funding campaign in future which shall not only provide financial but also medical care in the form of hearing aids, which are to be provided to the children under the auspices of RISE. Similarly, a free medical camp is also being planned by the department, to counsel the parents and provide awareness, enabling them in managing the needs of their special children.



In respect to the above mentioned visit, the medical students showed active participation, keen involvement, apparent motivation and an empathetic response; all of which are pertinent qualities for health care workers. The faculty of Community Medicine Department took active part in all the activities and guided the students throughout the field visit. The tasks assigned were completed and thoroughly assessed.

The overall experience of the students, faculty members, RISE staff members and most of all, the children, has been up to the mark, which gives further hope and light for future accomplishments so that all could benefit from such positive steps in the right direction.
