

Ethical Review Committee

The ethical committee of ORIC is composed of various influential members and their main objective is to protect the rights, safety dignity and well-being of the research participants. All the studies involving people as participants require a research ethics committee (REC) review. Moreover, it is mandatory for all the researches to demonstrate that they have adhered to the accepted ethical standards of a genuine research study in order to gain approval and increase their recruitment potential.

As part of the periodic review of the existing committees, the Ethical Review Committee (ERC) of CMH LMC & IOD was restructured to include a few new members, with the Chairperson as Prof Dr. Muhammad Nasir Saleem & Secretary as Dr. Ayesha Sadiqa. This was done with the aim of strengthening and diversifying the expertise of the committee. The ERC continues to work on the same principles of the old one, with the aim of ensuring that all research being conducted at CMH Lahore Medical College and Institute of Dentistry, is in accordance with national and international guidelines and that the rights and interests of research participants are guarded. After being received, each proposal is reviewed by all the members and a decision made after deliberations in the monthly meetings of the committee.

Publications by the Faculty and students of CMH LMC & IOD (Jan 2022-Dec 2023)

The publication record of CMH faculty members and students from Jan 2022 till Dec 2023 has been nothing short of excellent. A phenomenal number of 344 articles were published in renowned national & international journals. Of the 186 articles published in 2023, 160 were original researches,1 patent grant, 5 systematic reviews/Meta analysis, 5 narrative reviews, 4 case reports, 4 short communication/editorials, and 1 Book. Some of these publications were published in well-reputed journals with the high impact factors.

Publication Fee Reimbursement for Faculty

The main objective of the ORIC committee is to facilitate the publishers with basic, clinical and field research as well as innovations from various aspects such as scientific evaluation, ethical considerations, training in research-related areas and financial assistance applications. Encouraging involvement of corporate sector in supporting research and innovation activities through industrial funding is required. In the years 2022 & 2023, ORIC has financed a total of 344 publications of CMH Lahore Medical College and Institute of Dentistry with the total amount of reimbursement adding up to Rs. 1,568,402

Research Impact Fund

Research Impact Fund (RIF) is an internal research grant of CMH LMC & IOD for funding research projects on competitive merit for high-quality and promising scientific research that demonstrate strategic relevance and cast impact to the local industry and society. Ever year applications are called for RIF which grant up to PKR 100, 000 (one hundred thousand) per project with first round is held in December and second round in June. The grant not only improves the quality of research but also helps in capacity building through attaining new equipment which can used for future research projects as well.

Student Research Club (SRC) – CMH LMC & IOD

Student Research Club (SRC) of CMH LMC & IOD came into existence in January 2022, headed by Prof Dr Col Ashraf Chaudhry as the Staff President, Prof Dr Ansa Rabia as the Staff Advisor and Associate Prof Dr Sehrish Zaffar as the Staff Coordinator.






Workshop "Manuscript Writing skills"


9th PPA Conference at LUMHS Jamshoro


Networking session at World Physiotherapy Congress 2023 Dubai






Scientific Poster Competition in the 3rd LMDC International Dental Conference
